

BAMBOOS

Use as screens, informal hedges, clipped hedges, or container plants. Lends an Asian feel. For a tropical look combine with broad-leaved plants. Partial shade best in valley areas, full sun in cooler areas.

BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX 'Golden Goddess Bamboo'	Golden Goddess Bamboo	Clumping, 6-8', (6-10') Hardy to about 15 degrees
BAMBUSA OLDHAMII	Clumping Giant Timber Bamboo	Clumping, 15-25', (20-55') Hardy to about 20 degrees.
BAMBUSA VENTRICOSA	Buddha's Belly	Clumping, 3-6', (6-30') Hardy to about 20 degrees
CHUSQUEA CORONALIS		Clumping, 8-15' Hardy to about 25 degrees
DREPANOSTACHYUM FALCATUM	Blue Bamboo	Clumping, 20' Hardy to about 15 degrees
FARGESIA NITIDA	Fountain Bamboo	Clumping, 6-12' Very hardy to 0-10 degrees
OTATEA ACUMINATA AZTECTORUM	Mexican Weeping Bamboo	Clumping, 8-12', (12-15') Hardy to about 20 degrees, but can be deciduous
PHYLLOSTACHYS AUREA	Golden Bamboo	Running, 6-10', (10-20') Hardy to about 10 degrees
PHYLLOSTACHYS NIGRA	Black Bamboo	Running, 8-15', (10-20') Hardy to about 10 degrees
SASA PYGMAEAE		Running, 1/2-1 1/2 ft. Hardy to 0 degrees or less
