

NANDINA Heavenly Bamboo

Evergreen shrub. Can lose leaves at 10 degrees. Provides fall and winter foliage color. Sun or shade. Best in rich soil with ample water, but plants tolerate drought when established. Resistant to oak root fungus. Most useful for light, airy vertical effects; narrow restricted areas. Good for hedge or screen, as tub plant, for bonsai. Dramatic with night lighting.

NANDINA DOMESTICA	6-8' tall	Purple, bronze tints in fall, crimson in winter. Red berries.	Good for hedge or screen.
DOMESTICA COMPACTA	4-5' tall	Narrower, numerous leaflets	Lacy look.
HARBOUR DWARF	1 1/2-2' tall	Orange-red to bronze-red winter color.	More free spreading. Good ground cover.
NANA PURPUREA (Compacta Nana, or Nana)	1' tall	Broad, cupped foliage. Red winter color	Slow to spread.
WOODS DWARF	1' tall	Crimson-orange to scarlet in winter.	Compact, rounded, densely foliated.
FILAMENTOSA	Slow to 4 ' tall and as wide	Apricot in fall	Thread-like leaves.
GULF STREAM	3' tall	Bronze to red in fall	Well balanced, dwarf and compact
MOON BAY	2-3' tall	Young lime green foliage	Compact, globe shaped.
