

RAPHIOLEPIS Indian Hawthorne

Evergreen shrubs. Attractive for dense background plantings, low dividers, informal hedges. Bloom late fall or mid winter to late spring. Grow in full sun or partial shade. Will stand fairly dry conditions but also will tolerate frequent waterings they get when planted near lawn or flower beds.

JACK EVANS	To about 4' tall with wider spread	Bright pink flowers	Compact and spreading
PINKIE	To about 3'	Pink flowers	Neat, dwarf variety
PINK LADY	4-5' tall 4-6' wide	Deep pink flowers	Vigorous grower
MAJESTIC BEAUTY	Can reach 15' tall	Fragrant light pink flowers	Use as background shrub or small tree
Raphiolepis umbellata minor GULF GREEN	3-4' tall	White flowers	Compact growth habit
