DISEASE RESISTANCE CODES: Hybrids are often bred to resist diseases.
V- Verticillium **f F1-** Fusarium wilt *race 1* **f F2-** Fusarium wilt *race 2* **f N-** Nematodes **f T-** Tobacco Mosaic
HABITS: INDETERMINATE: Blossoms & Fruit develop progressively. Harvest will last several months.
DETERMINATE: Blossoms & fruit develop on plant in one cycle. Harvest time is short- 7-10 days

Variety	Resistance /Type	Fruit Characteristics
Abraham Lincoln: 87 days	VFNASf- Indeterminate- Hybrid x heirloom 1923	6-8 oz. Bright red, mild flavor, high yields.
Better Boy: 75 days	VFNASf – Indeterminate	Popular. Excellent flavor, 16oz
Big Beef: 73 days	VFFNTASf – Indeterminate	9-16 oz substitute for Beefsteak. 1994 AAS winner for Best Tasting
Big Rainbow: 80-85 days	Indeterminate	Up to 4 ½ inches, orange fruits with red spots & streaks. Low acid content. One of Martha Stewart's "7 Best"
Black Krim: 69 days Black Sea region of Russia	Indeterminate - Heirloom	4- 6 oz sweet, deep-red skin & flesh, green shoulders. 1998 winner for Best Tasting
Brandywine: 90-100 days Amish	Indeterminate - Heirloom -1885	16 oz, deep pink skin, red flesh, spicy unique flavor.
Caspian Pink: 80 days From the Caspian Sea region of Russia	Indeterminate - Heirloom	The world's finest tomato? Has beat 'Brandywine' in Calif. taste trials for the last 3 years .
Celebrity	VF1 & VF2 – Determinate	8 oz, light red skin, good flavor
Champion	VFNT - Indeterminate	10 oz, good for sandwiches, high yields
Cherokee Purple: 80-90 days Native American	Indeterminate - Heirloom Mild tolerance to drought & to common diseases.	4-6 oz, skin & flesh interesting pinks & purples. Very unusual.
Costoluto Genovese: 90 days	Indeterminate Good disease resistance.	7 oz. Ribbed fruits with fine, sweet flavor. One of Martha Stewart's "7 Best"
Dona: 65 days Award winner from France	VFFNT – Indeterminate	Deep red medium sized fruits. Perfect acid to sugar ratio.
Early Girl: 57 days	VFF - Indeterminate	Earliest fruit, 4-6 oz, slicing & salads, bears all summer.
Enchantment: 70 days	VFFN – Indeterminate	3 oz EGG shaped fruit, delicate flavor. Excellent for slicing and for sauces.
Green Grape: 70 days Europe	Determinate	The first fully-ripened green cherry tomato. Profuse bearer of 'sweet 1" fruits. Green sauces, soups, garnishes, & more. One of Martha Stewart's "7 Best"
Green Zebra: 78 days	Indeterminate	2-4 oz. Very unusual striped fruits, bright green, yellow, orange. Excellent tomato flavor, high yields. One of Martha Stewart's "7 Best"
Golden Pearl	Indeterminate heirloom	½" fruit, yellow, heavy producer, luscious taste
Heartland	VFN- Indeterminate dwarf: no staking needed	6 oz, excellent flavor, good for containers
Italian Gold: 70 days	VF - Determinate	3-4 oz gold-orange pear type, heavy producer, gorgeous & popular. "Queen of the sauce tomatoes"
Juliet: 60 days	Indeterminate	1 oz grape-like fruits borne in clusters. Sweet flavor. No cracking. 1999 AAS Winner
Lillian's Yellow Heirloom: 95-98 days Manchester, Tenn.	Indeterminate - Heirloom	16 oz, clear yellow fruits. Rich texture, mild, creamy taste.
Momotaro: 78 days Japanese	VFN- Indeterminate	8 oz, pink skin & flesh, very sweet, high yields
Old Flame: 80 days	Indeterminate - Heirloom, newly available for retail.	Big, beautiful fruit ripen toward summer's end, without cracking. Sunny yellow, shot through with rose-red. Creamy texture, sweet & mild. Beautiful on the table.
Principe Borghese: 75 days Italian	Determinate	Plum shaped fruits, very meaty, with few seeds. A favorite for drying.
Roma (aka La Roma)	VF1 & VF2- Determinate	3-4 oz, pear shaped, heavy yield, good for sauces & canning
Red Currant: 65 days	Indeterminate - Old wild tomato	Pea-sized fruits, crunchy, fruity flavor. Ideal for salads & snacks.
Riesentrabe: 70 days German	Indeterminate - Heirloom	The name translates to 'giant bunch of grapes'. Excellent flavor, similar to Beefsteak, but in 1 oz. Fruits.
Sugar Lump 65-75 days (aka Gardener's Delight) German	Indeterminate - Heirloom	Deep red fruits to 1 inch in diameter. Exceptionally sweet. Heavy yields.
White Wonder: 80- 90 days	Indeterminate	Small to medium-sized fruits. Mild, sweet flavor, white inside & out when ripe. Slicing, canning, juicing. One of Martha Stewart's "7 Best"
Yellow Pear: 78 days	Indeterminate Heirloom	Petite 1 ¾" yellow, pear shaped fruit, pleasant, mild flavor. Vigorous producer.
