

Growing WILDFLOWERS from seed

Planting time

Sow seeds fall through early spring.

Soil

Well drained, preferably weed free.

Light

Unless sowing a shade mixture, requires a minimum of 6-8 hours of sun daily.

Water

Seeds require ample moisture to germinate. Water lightly and frequently to keep soil moist. As plants grow gradually reduce water. Established plants require water only when showing signs of stress.

Fertilizer

Apply an all purpose fertilizer through the growing season for optimum results.

Problems

Seed does not germinate

Soil too dry, seeds washed away in heavy rain, seed buried too deeply.
